

How to Install the Secure Browser Through a Local Network – Mac OS X



A special secure browser must be available on each computer to be used for HSA online testing. We strongly recommend that you install the secure browser on each computer to be used for testing. You can push the browser out to all computers through a network by copying browser files from the network to individual computers or through third-party programs to run the installers, such as Apple Remote Desktop.

This document provides network installation instructions for computers using the Mac OS X 10.3–10.6 through the Apple Remote Desktop application.

MAC OS X SECURE BROWSER INSTALLATION USING APPLE REMOTE DESKTOP

1. Begin using an administrator computer on your network. This computer should have Apple Remote Desktop installed and running.
2. Download the correct Mac OS X browser from the HSA Portal.
NOTE: Make sure that you install the correct version of the browser for each computer that students will be using for online testing.
3. Click on the downloaded icon to unzip and save the .dmg file onto your administrator computer.
4. Open Apple Remote Desktop.
5. In the Apple Remote Desktop window, select a Computer List.
6. Select one or more computers from the Computer List onto which you would like to install the secure browser.
7. Select Manage > Copy Items.
8. Select the browser .dmg file that you installed on your administrator machine.
9. Select copy options, including your preferred destination on the target machine.
10. Click **Copy**.
