

How to Install the Secure Browser to a Shared Directory - Windows



A special secure browser must be available on each computer to be used for HSA online testing. We strongly recommend that you download and install the secure browser manually onto each computer to be used for testing.

We advise against running the Windows secure browser directly from the network. It will result in a substantial increase in network traffic, and users may experience delays. However, if you must use this setup, follow the instructions below.

WINDOWS INSTALLATION

1. Install the browser on your server, following the standard directions at <http://www.alohahsa.org/online/browsers/default.html>.
2. Create a shortcut in the same directory by right-clicking on the **Kiosk_NoAdmin1.exe** icon and selecting "Create Shortcut." Rename the new shortcut **SecureBrowser3.0**.
3. To each user (computer) profile, add the following command, which will execute upon login through the user group login script:

```
"<X>"\kiosk.exe -createProfile default  
COPY "<X> \SecureBrowser3.0.Ink" "%USERPROFILE%\Desktop"
```

<X> refers to the shared directory from which the browser will be run. The script will need to reference the correct directory.

Please note the "1" in the filename (kiosk_noAdmin1.exe). This is the file that you must run if you are running directly from the server.
